"Transitional Project" -- John Calvin Thinking Outside the Box!

A subcommittee of COM, working with Pastoral Presbyter Malinda Spencer, is creating an innovative program to help churches work through their interim tasks—even during a pandemic--in preparation for calling a new minister or moving forward in whatever way God is calling them. The "Transitional Project" Committee (comprised of Reina Daleske, St. Andrew at Kimberling City; Kent Hollingsworth, HR; Susan Leonard, Trinity-Springfield; and Dennis Winzenried, HR) presented its ideas at the called Presbytery meeting Tuesday.

Presbytery voted to amend the 2021 Budget to provide \$20,000 to fund the Transitional Project by hiring a quarter-time Ruling Elder, Greg Emery, to lead the work, which will begin virtually due to COVID-19. Although churches that participate directly in the program will contribute financially, the Presbytery will provide the lion's share of the funding. Stay tuned for more details to come!

PULPIT SUPPLY LY for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting minister should ordinarily receive \$125.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (2021 IRS rate \$0.56 per mile) for one worship service. If two (2) services are required the honorarium is \$160.00 plus mileage. If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. The honorarium for moderating a session or congregational meeting is \$60 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.
