## Leader Formation Webinar for Deacons and Ruling Elders

There's still time for the ruling elders and deacons in your congregations to register for the OGA's webinar, "Investing in Ruling Elders and Deacons: Good Stewards of God's Grace," Wednesday, March 30, from 7:00-8:30 pm Eastern. These church leaders will benefit from a deeper understanding of worship and their roles in settings such as the Service for the Lord's Day; services of ordination, installation, and commissioning; the extended service of communion; and other ministries of compassion and care with those who are sick, homebound, or hospitalized. David Gambrell, Associate for Worship in the PC(USA)'s Office of Theology and Worship, will lead the conversation.

You must register by March 23 to allow time for interpretation to be arranged in Spanish and Korean for those who request it. There is no fee—your per capita contributions at work! If you are unable to participate live, there is no need to register in order to access the recording in English afterwards.

Thank you for the honor of serving in God's mission alongside you.

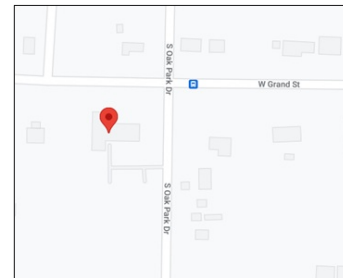
