CREATIVE MINISTRIES GRANT



The Creative Ministries grant is a one-year grant open to all churches. The application should refelct a creative mission proposal, for which has not been previously budgeted.

Funds available are the total of the budgeted amount of \$10,000 and half of the offering of each of the four stated presbytery meetings: May 2022, August 2022, November 2022, and February 2023. Across time, grants will be awarded in the three geographical regions of the John Calvin Presbytery. No grant application should exceed the total amount available.

The estimated amount for the 2023 Creative Ministry Grant is \$11,220.

The application should be accompanied by a copy of the minutes where the mission project was approved by the Session and signed by the clerk.

Timeline: Application should be received by September 15, 2023, and the grants awarded in November.

Creative Ministry Grant recipients should expect to participate in the creation of a "project story" that can be shared on the JCP website. The hope is that by sharing the story, others can benefit by example. JCP, in order to encourage creativity, will seriously and prayerfully consider any applications that come forward. Within two months of the completion of the mission program, a report shall be submitted detailing the numbers of individuals involved (church congregation(s) and community), total monies spent, and a subjective evaluation of the mission project.

Once received by the presbytery office, proposals shall be reviewed and considered by the Grants Committee.

The Grants Committee will select recipients based on consideration of the following:

- Appropriateness of project within the scope of presbytery mission.
- Rationale of funds requested with regard to projected outcome.
- Potential benefit to larger church.
- Clear, specific and complete planning including means of evaluation.
