The Called Meeting of John Calvin Presbytery was called to order at 4:11 PM by Moderator the Rev. Daniel Davis, followed by an opening prayer by Elder Toni Spieth. Elder Carol Raquet read Psalm 126:1-6.

Stated Clerk Becky Schwandt stated the purpose of this Called Meeting was to examine the Rev. Changwon Seo for membership in John Calvin Presbytery and full-time call as the installed pastor of The Presbyterian Church, Pittsburg, Kansas beginning January 8th, 2024. And, if the way be clear, to elect an Administrative Commission to install him on a date to be determined.

Based on attendance and the participation list Stated Clerk, Becky Schwandt, declared that a quorum was present for this called meeting of John Calvin Presbytery. (A quorum necessary to transact business at each stated meeting of the presbytery shall consist of not less than six (6) ministers and as many ruling elders as may be present providing that at least four (4) particular churches are represented by ruling elders.)

## **Report of the Committee on Ministry**

Moderator of the Committee on Ministry Elder Reina Daleske spoke briefly on COM's role concerning the calling of new pastors. She then invited the moderator of The Presbyterian Church's PNC, Elder Mark Denton, to speak to the search process of calling the Rev. Changwon Seo.

Elder Mark Denton spoke about the long search process and how at times it was discouraging. He thanked the presbytery for its support of the PNC. They are very pleased to have the Rev. Changwon Seo and look forward to working with him in ministry for many years.

COM Moderator Reina Daleske introduced Changwon Seo for examination and asked Changwon the first question. After Changwon answer the first question, the floor was open to questions from the presbyters. Following this examination, the motion was made, seconded and approved to arrest the examination. Changwon temporarily left the meeting. The motion was made, seconded and approved to suspend the examination and that presbytery approve the Rev. Changwon Seo for membership in John Calvin Presbytery and install her as the full-time pastor at The Presbyterian Church, Pittsburg, KS. Motion passed.

The motion was made on behalf of the Committee on Ministry to approve the terms of call as listed below for the Rev. Changwon Seo with a start date of January 8th, 2024. Motion passed.

## The Rev. Changwon Seo Short Biography

He also enjoys being challenged by the Bible and theological books. He, as a Christian Coach, likes listening actively to people and encouraging them to find the ways the Holy Spirit leads.

#### The Rev. Changwon Seo Statement of Faith

I believe in the Trinity, God who is the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Father created all things in heaven and on earth, and God sent us his only begotten Son, Jesus Christ as the light of the world to save us through him. Anyone who believes in Jesus will receive salvation in God's grace and love.
