The sight of a solitary candle glowing night after night in every window of the "Brick Church" tells the story of a congregation that has served as a light to its community for a very long time.

At a recent session meeting, the Ruling Elders recounted special stories of their congregation:

This is "home." One member recounted lots of good changes that have occurred in the eighty years she has attended, including building the fellowship hall, installing a furnace, and adding air conditioning. (The



addition of indoor plumbing was also a positive change, although many funny stories have been told about taking children out of church to the outhouses!)

The church exudes a "warm family feeling." "This church is such a part of me," stated a member whose life has been lived against the backdrop of this church, beginning with her grandparents who attended here and were buried here, her parents who met and married here, her children who were baptized here, and her husband whose funeral was held here

Through the years new people were welcomed and included, regardless of church background.

The strength of their relationships brought people here and kept them here.

The Church family surrounds each member in difficult times: "No one is alone."

Other favorite memories shared with visitors from the Presbytery included:

• The annual ice cream supper

- The Thanksgiving praise supper
- Hayrides and monthly meals at the church
- Rolling over lemons in a wagon to juice them for the national Orr Family Reunion which they host each year. (The Orr Family began the church long ago. An electric juicer has replaced the wagons.)
- Attending Sunday School with all the other kids in the balcony

Crane Presbyterian Church has been engaged in a program for the past few years to reach out to children within the community of Crane through a monthly cooking class and fellowship. Through coordination with the school counselor, two to three fourth through sixth grade students are invited to come to the Church to participate in the process of meal preparation. This year, the Church is giving each of the participants a crock pot to keep and take home along with the ingredients to prepare a meal. The November participants prepared "Chicken and Dumplings" using canned biscuits, along with a salad, bread and chocolate oreo "poke" cake. The students are encouraged to invite their families to join them when the meal is ready and Church members are encouraged to join as well. The meal is served "family style" and the students help set the table and fill drinks. In addition to learning some easy recipes, the students along with Church members, enjoy the opportunity to visit and build relationships with each other. Crane Presbyterian is excited to model the service and outreach of a Matthew 25 Church.

PULPIT SUPPLY for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting minister should ordinarily receive \$100.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (2019 IRS rate \$0.58 per mile). Pulpit Supply is \$100.00 with the understanding that is only if one (1) service is to be prepared. It was approved by COM that if two (2) services are required the honorarium would be \$150.00. If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. Honorarium for moderating a session is \$50 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.
