Because of a change to religious worker exclusion rules made in July 2021 (<u>https://studentaid.gov/manage-loans/forgiveness-cancellation/public-service</u>) and the recently announced "Limited Opportunity Waiver," (<u>https://studentaid.gov/announcements-events/pslf-limited-waiver</u>)

PC(USA) leaders who may not have previously qualified for qualified for Public Service Loan Forgiveness could have their loans forgiven much sooner than expected.

Any PC(USA) is welcome to join either webinar. Student Loan experts from PeopleJoy will present the material and will be available to answer general questions.
