

### **General Assembly Update**

### JCP Overture to General Assembly Passes in Committee

In 2019, John Calvin Presbytery began the process of writing an overture to the General Assembly of the PC(USA) to address the disparity in benefits provided to Mid Council Staff by the Board of Pensions. After nearly three years, due largely to the fact that nearly all business sent to the 2020 General Assembly was delayed to 2022, our overture "On Benefit Equity Among Mid Council Executive Staff" has passed its first hearing with flying colors.

On Tuesday, June 21 our overture, designated MC-02, was taken up by the Mid Council Committee. After several hours of presentations, questions, and deliberation the committee voted 29 to 4 to approve our overture with amendment. JCP was represented by Rev. Chris Miller as our Overture Advocate. We also received supportive testimony from our Transitional Synod Executive, RE Tony De La Rosa, and members of the Advocacy Committee for Women's Concerns and the Advisory Committee on Social Witness Policy — both standing committees of the General Assembly. A highlight of the

deliberation was a visit to the committee by the Rev. J. Herbert Nelson, Stated Clerk of the General Assembly, who spoke in support of our overture, encouraging the committee to consider it an issue of ecclesiology not of finances.

The next step in the process is a hearing before the full assembly in the coming weeks.

### IRS increases mileage rate for remainder of 2022

IR-2022-124, June 9, 2022 — The Internal Revenue Service today announced an increase in the optional standard mileage rate for the final 6 months of 2022.

IRS RATE FOR MILEAGE BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 WILL BE 62.5 CENTS PER MILE.

PULPIT SUPPLY for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting

minister should ordinarily receive \$125.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (July through December 2022 IRS rate \$0.625 per mile) for one worship service.

If two (2) services are required the honorarium is \$160.00 plus mileage. If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. The honorarium for moderating a session or congregational meeting is \$60 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.

### Citizenship Test / ESL Practice

IISMO has been working on creating citizenship packets for clients. For anyone who does not know, clients with refugee status can receive benefits for up to 7 years. After that, they are no longer eligible. That is why it is important for them to become citizens, especially those over 65 years of age. However, some of our clients are wary of taking the test because they are not confident in their English ability. That is why we are creating packets for them to study (see attached doc to peruse the 100 possible questions on the test). If you or someone you know is interested in helping them study for the naturalization test,

please let me know! Right now, we are looking for 3-4 volunteers to start.
