

### Top honors from the Academy of Parish Clergy

Each year, the <u>Academy of Parish Clergy</u> honors the top 10 books for parish ministry, which "display excellence and helpfulness to clergy," as well as the Reference Book Top 5 list.

The second Top 10 honoree, "Neighbors: Christians and Muslims Building Community" by Deanna Ferree Womack, offers a different story than the one of conflict and hostility that we've been told about Christians and Muslims in America. In fact, Christians and Muslims have not always fought or lived in fear of



one another. In "Neighbors," Womack lays the groundwork for the members of both religions to understand, converse and cooperate with one another. Womack's emphasis on interfaith engagement and awareness demonstrate how Christians can move into real dialogue and common action with Muslims in the United States.

Deanna Ferree Womack is Assistant Professor of History of Religions and Multifaith Relations at Emory University's Candler School of Theology and a minister in the Presbyterian Church (USA). Deanna grew up in Nevada Missouri. The daughter of the Reverend Greg Ferree, former pastor of First Presbyterian Nevada, now honorably retired minister of John Calvin Presbytery. Deanna delivered the sermon for our first zoom meeting of presbytery May 2020.



**PULPIT SUPPLY** for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting minister should ordinarily receive \$125.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (2021 IRS rate \$0.56 per mile) for one worship service. If two (2) services are required the honorarium is \$160.00 plus mileage. If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. The honorarium for moderating a session or congregational meeting is \$60 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.
