

#### Standing in Solidarity with those Traumatized by Violence

**Greetings Friends** 

As we observe with grief and horror the racist killing spree that occurred in Buffalo, New York and the hate crime perpetrated against the Irvine Taiwanese PCUSA church in California last weekend, please join us in praying for the victims, their families, the city of Buffalo, Laguna Woods, California, and the Los Ranchos Presbytery.

Together we denounce the manifestation of white supremacist violence that is antisemitic, anti-Black, anti-immigrant, and steeped in fear, hatred, and anger. Together we stand against the theory of "white replacement" that fueled the attack in Buffalo.

Together we stand in solidarity with those traumatized by the violence that occurred during a luncheon at the Irvine Taiwanese PCUSA church. Let us continue to commit ourselves as a presbytery to ministering in the way of Jesus, a way that calls out racist violence that tarnishes the beloved community at the heart of the good news of Jesus Christ we proclaim.

The Committee on Ministry voted that all ministers serving churches in JCP are required to attend training. This includes the pulpit supply list, and anyone preaching regularly in congregations.


## Not Your Parents' Offering Plate Book Study

I have made some changes to the form that will hopefully help all volunteers in the future. As such, I would like to state or remind all volunteers of the following:

- 1. The weekly form is not a good communication tool. If you have a question, it is best to email me.
- 2. It is best to submit the form within same month as volunteer services. You can do this after every time you volunteer, once a week or once a month. If you do not submit the form within the same month, please specify in the comments section at the end of the form
- 3. Use one name and one spelling for all volunteer reports. This helps me count how many people have been actively involved in a certain month. For example, my name is Charlotte, but most people call me Charley. It is important that I choose one name and stick with it
- 4. Do not combine reports. Please only submit one report for one person.
- 5. Every question besides the first two and the last question should be answered with a whole number. Please do not put numbers or letters in those responses.
