New Presbytery Minimums....

At the November 5th presbytery meeting, COM will recommend that Presbytery approve minimum terms of call for 2023:

- Minimum full-time salary (cash and housing allowance) \$46,000
- Board of Pensions (increased to 39%) \$17,940
- Total Effective Salary plus Board of Pensions dues \$63,940.

(These figures do not include reimbursable expenses which are part of the Terms of Call.)

Hope is something outside ourselves that tethers us to safety and helps us keep going, even when we can't see our way.
