## Opportunity to Receive Coaching & Cohort Training

Missouri Union Presbytery, in partnership with the Omaha Presbyterian Seminary Foundation (OPSF), and two other presbyteries, applied for and received a one million dollar grant from the Lily Foundation. The program is called "Pastoral Leadership Revitalization."

All pastors in the Synod of Mid America who are new to rural ministry in the last five years are invited to participate. There are a total of 15 openings and they will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. All costs of program participation are covered by the grant.

The Pastoral Leadership Revitalization program is designed to increase pastoral resilience and stem the attrition rate of ordained and lay pastors. The Omaha Presbyterian Seminary Foundation is aware that pastors in isolated communities, whether rural or urban communities, and first call pastors, are especially susceptible to feeling isolated, and therefore, is eager to support and encourage such pastors in their ministry. A vital way to support pastors is through a coaching mentor, a fellow pastor who can offer wisdom, guidance and encouragement on your journey as a pastor. We are inviting pastors with great potential to partner with a coaching mentor,

that they may be even more successful in their ministry. You are one such pastor.

#### What will you receive by participating in this program?

You will be part of a cohort of pastors and commission ruling elders, engaged in revitalizing ministry in their congregations.

You will be energized for ministry by attending the retreats for pastors and CREs.

Your family will be supported by attending the retreats for families.

Your congregation will benefit from the ways in which you are growing from working with a mentor and attending retreats.

The coaching you receive is valued at \$1,000/year. The retreats would cost about \$500/retreat. You will receive these benefits at no cost to you.

#### What will be expected of you?

Attend retreats offered by your presbytery. The first retreat will be September 15-18, 2019. There will be two retreats per year in 2020 and 2021.

Meet with your coaching mentor at least once a month, either face-to-face, by phone, or virtually (such as through Zoom).

Be willing to be coachable and teachable.

Be open to participating in spiritual direction.

We ask that you commit to this program through the end of 2021.

# 1C LIVING WATERS

A team consisting of six Presbyterians from John Calvin Presbytery, one Presbyterian from Heartland Presbytery and one Nazarene, traveled to the Dominican Republic March 20-26, 2019. They placed a purifying water system into a public school of 400 children, Centro Educativo Alberto Hernandez Rosario School.

Sharon Marsh was the administrator-team leader, while Grant Spieth, Chris Scrivener, and Martha Bledsoe were on the installation team. Esther Cozzens assisted on both teams. Toni Spieth Ted Scott, Carol Minton were on the spiritual and education team. They taught Bible lessons reminding others that Jesus is the Living Water for our bodies and our souls. The team also taught health modules reviewing germ theory and healthy behavior as well as activities discussing healthy hands, filtration, germs hate soap, and how easily germs spread to one another. Coloring, games, and charades were used to include the entire class with the lessons.

We were able to celebrate with our partners that clean water could be made for the benefit of the children and their families. Together we were able to drink the system purified water and praise God that the children in this community will no longer get sick or die from drinking contaminated water. It will save the school from \$300-500 per month not having to buy 5-gallon containers of safe water.

Water is the crisis of our time. Over 600 million people around the globe suffer from lack of access to a safe water source. Nearly half of all deaths of children under the age of five are caused by preventable water-related diseases.

**PULPIT SUPPLY** for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting minister should ordinarily receive \$100.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (2019 IRS rate \$0.58 per mile). Pulpit Supply is \$100.00 with the understanding that is only if one (1) service is to be prepared. It was approved by COM that if two (2) services are required the honorarium would be \$150.00.

If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. Honorarium for moderating a session is \$50 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.
