
Lent in Plain Sight: A Devotion through Ten Objects

This is a weekly study on Wednesdays beginning on February 24th March 3rd March 10th March 17th March 24th March 31st and ending on April 7th.

The study begins at 7:00 pm and last about one hour.

The devotional readings, in Lent in Plain Sight by Jill Duffield, begin on Ash Wednesday, February 17th. Each week we will discuss one of the 10 objects which consist of Dust, Bread, Cross, Coins, Shoes, Oil, and Coats, Towels, Thorns and Stones. Each daily reading includes questions for reflection and a prayer for the day.

This study allows us to see how God's still, small voice communicates through the ordinary as we find meaning through the reading of scripture as we walk alongside Jesus during his journey to the cross.

The constitutional questions asked of leaders within the PC(USA) when they are ordained, installed, and commissioned is the focus of a new resource created to assist teaching elders as they serve in ministry with ruling elders and deacons. *Coming Alive in Christ: Training for PC(USA) Ruling Elders and Deacons based on the Constitutional Questions* provides a study of these beliefs that are central to our lives of faith and is available through **Equip**, the church's online training platform. Beginning with an introduction on baptism, call, and membership, the study for each question has been written by a leader from across the diversity of the church with questions for reflection or discussion included in each section. Leader guides and a visual supplement are also included and available for download. The resource is a focus of the Year of Leader Formation. PULPIT SUPPLY LY for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting minister should ordinarily receive \$125.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (2021 IRS rate \$0.56 per mile) for one worship service. If two (2) services are required the honorarium is \$160.00 plus mileage. If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. The honorarium for moderating a session or congregational meeting is \$60 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.
